



Qatar is currently undergoing a rapid transformation as it flexes to accommodate its growing population and prepares for hosting the World Cup in 2022. The state has grown rapidly over the past 20 years but now sees growth accelerate further with extensive road, rail and infrastructure projects now underway. For the foreseeable future, construction is likely to continue at a heady pace, with iconic projects set to start soon, such as the Sharq crossing and the various World Cup stadiums.

Whilst Contractors are currently offered a vast array of contracting opportunities, many risks on delivery remain, with some risks peculiar to working within Qatar and the wider MENA region.
